MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING

JUNE 27, 2013

Pursuant to due notice, the South Dakota Building Authority met on Thursday, June 27, 2013 at 2:25 P.M., CDT via telephone. Tom Graham, Chairman, instructed the Executive Secretary to call the roll.

A quorum was declared by the Chairman and the meeting was called to order.

Mr. Don Templeton advised the Authority members that the notice of the meeting had been posted at the entrance of the office of the South Dakota Building Authority on June 19, 2013. A copy of that notice is attached hereto and is an integral part of the minutes (see Attachment #1).

The Chairman asked for consideration of the minutes for the February 20, 2013 meeting. Mr. Doug Hajek moved to approve the minutes of the meeting as presented, seconded by Mr. Joe Lien. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Contracts

Mr. Templeton reviewed the Chapman and Cutler rebate computation contract on file with the South Dakota Building Authority for calendar year 2013. The contract allows \$2,500 per computation not to exceed \$20,000. Mr. Douglas Hajek moved to approve the contract seconded by Mr. Dennis Neugebauer and upon roll call the ayes were: Graham, Haan, Hajek, Lien and Neugebauer, nays: none; abstain: none.

Mr. Templeton reviewed the Perkins Coie Contract on file with the South Dakota Building Authority relating to the Internal Revenue Service audit representation. Mr. Bruce Bonjour explained the work performed on the audit to the Board. Mr. Doug Hajek moved to approve the contract at \$15,000 seconded by Mr. Dennis Neugebauer and upon roll call the ayes were: Graham, Haan, Hajek, Lien and Neugebauer, nays: none; abstain: none.

Mr. Templeton reviewed the South Dakota Health and Educational Facilities Authority contract with the South Dakota Building Authority on file with the South Dakota Building Authority for fiscal year 2014 at a monthly rate of \$13,461.63 for personal services, office space and utilities. Mr. Dennis Neugebauer moved to approve the contract seconded by Mr. Doug Hajek and upon roll call the ayes were: Graham, Haan, Hajek, Lien and Neugebauer, nays: none; abstain: none.

Fiscal Year 2014 Operating Budget

The Chairman stated the next order of business would be to consider the fiscal year 2014 operating budget (see Attachment #2) for the South Dakota Building Authority. Mr. Templeton reviewed the South Dakota Health and Educational Facilities Authority salaries and allocations of these to the South Dakota Building Authority. Mr. Don Templeton presented a proposed budget to the Directors and there was discussion about the various individual budget items. The South Dakota Health and Educational Facilities Authority total salary allocation is \$91,103. These allocations will be reviewed at fiscal year end to actual hours spent and payments for these adjustments will be made accordingly. The beginning cash balance is expected to be \$823,348 on July 1, 2013 with revenues of \$701,373, expenses of \$749,490 and an expected transfer to the State of South Dakota in the amount of \$73,348. The ending cash balance is expected to be \$701,883 on June 30, 2014.

After further discussion, it was moved by Mr. Dennis Haan to approve the fiscal year 2014 operating budget, seconded by Mr. Dennis Neugebauer and upon roll call the ayes were: Graham, Haan, Hajek, Lien and Neugebauer, nays: none; abstain: none.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Fiscal Year 2014 Operating Budget

The Chairman stated the next order of business would be to consider the fiscal year 2014 operating budget for the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program. Mr. Templeton presented a proposed budget (*see Attachment #3*) to the Directors and there was discussion about the various individual budgeted items.

After further discussion, it was moved by Mr. Dennis Haan to approve the operating budget as presented, seconded by Mr. Joe Lien and upon roll call the ayes were: Graham, Haan, Hajek, Lien and Neugebauer, nays: none; abstain: none

South Dakota State University - Avera Science Center

Mr. Todd Meierhenry explained that he talked with Mr. Rich Kormen of Avera Health and showed the Board an email that the \$1,500,000 annual payment to South Dakota State University is recorded as a donation from Avera Health.

Mr. Templeton explained that Avera Health records this donation expense as an operating expense. The Internal Revenue Service agent concluded that all of the Avera \$1,500,000 donation should be advertising expense due to an Avera sign on the Avera Science Center building.

Both Bruce Bonjour and Todd Meierhenry disagreed with the Internal Revenue Service agent and thought this email would be good for our file to support this as a donation.

Mr. Bonjour also suggested that any future bond issues with potential naming rights should be initially more closely examined to ensure compliance with federal tax law.

The Chairman stated that there being no further business at this meeting, the meeting would be adjourned at 3:00 P.M. CDT.
